

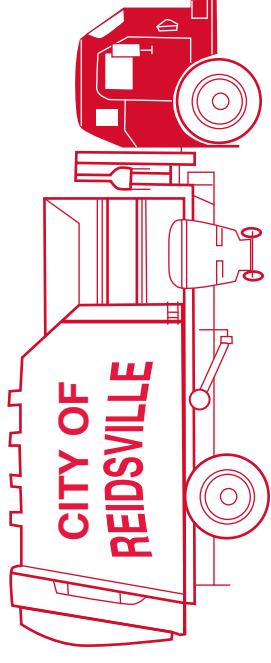

Cooking With Fats, Oils and Grease!

The Public Works Department urges residents to be careful when disposing of fats, oil and grease after cooking. If not disposed of properly, the waste can result in residents having to call a plumber to remove residues that block pipes and sewer lines. Fats, oils and grease (F.O.G.) come from meat, gravy and sauces, baking goods, cooking oil, lard, margarine, shortening and butter that can lead to problems with pipes in the home and city sewer lines from homes and businesses, especially restaurants. "Think of it like arteries that get clogged". It's not overnight, but slowly, more and more, the lines get coated with cooking grease, which results in clogged drains.

City residents are encouraged to dispose of excess grease and fat in a sealable container at the Recycling Center, where it can be poured into the container labeled "Greenlight Biofuels" for eventual reuse as heating oil and fuel. Loose Leaf Collection

Annual curbside loose leaf pickup begins the first week of November, and ends the first full week of January each year. Please observe the following rules:

- Leaves must be clear of brush, sticks and other waste.
- Place loose leaves at the curb or edge of pavement (not in the roadway)
- Place leaves away from storm drains or parked cars
- Leaves should be placed for pick-up by 7:00 am on your scheduled day.
- All areas will be serviced weekly (on the same day as in the past)
- The schedule could vary based on volume.
- After loose leaf collection ends you must bag your leaves to be collected by the Sanitation Department.
