# **Boil Water Advisory for Reidsville lifted**

The Boil Water Advisory for users of Reidsville’s water system has been lifted.

The Advisory went into effect around 7 p.m. Tuesday, June 23, when Water Treatment Plant staff determined the Holiday Loop Water Tank was at a low level following a water main break earlier in the day on Park Lane. Public Works crews were able to make the repairs to the water line Tuesday night.

Water Treatment Plant staff collected water samples throughout the City’s water system, which were incubated for a 24-hour period. Mid-day Thursday, June 25, the water sample testing showed no contamination, and the Boil Water Advisory was lifted.

The City of Reidsville appreciates the patience of our residents and local businesses while repairs were made to the 12-inch waterline on Park Lane. Our Street Department has repaired the roadway following the pipe repair and laid down gravel for the street’s eventual repaving.
